State of MN Broadband Maps and Data

DEED has a variety of standard statewide and county maps, including:

- An interactive map that shows broadband availability by address, town, township, county, etc.
- Maps that show which areas are served, underserved and unserved.
- Maps that highlight the best broadband infrastructure available in an area – fiber, cable modem, DSL, fixed wireless and cellular data.
- Maps that show the household density of unserved areas.
- Maps that use data to provide county data on broadband availability.

FCC Maps

The FCC is the primary collector of broadband deployment and services information in the US. Many of their programs use maps to identify program eligible areas.
