Rank: 37 (out of 87) with broadband at 100/20 megabits per second (Mbps)

Background

Every year since 2017 Blandin Foundation has contracted with Ann Treacy of Treacy Information Services to synthesize data from the Minnesota Office of Broadband Development and broadband news from communities across the state to gauge progress toward the state broadband goals (2022: 25 Mbps down and 3 Mbps up and 2026: 100 Mbps down and 20 Mbps up).

Leaders can use this information to plan and act to improve broadband access and use in their communities.

Nicollet County: data and community action

With concerted effort, Nicollet County could be poised to meet the broadband speed goals for both 2022 and 2026.

Nicollet County has benefited from a state broadband grant:

2015 - MVTV Wireless Middle Mile -- Grant award: \$808,080
This project is a Middle Mile broadband infrastructure buildout to upgrade backhaul capacity between site locations within 20 southwestern Minnesota counties: Blue Earth, Chippewa, Cottonwood, Jackson, Kandiyohi, Lac Qui Parle, Lincoln, Lyon, Meeker, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Pipestone, Rock, Redwood, Renville, Sibley Swift, Watonwan, and Yellow Medicine.

It's difficult to get a clear picture of Nicollet's progress toward the speed goals given the dip in 2018 – caused by provider Nuevera going more granular with its DSL data - but it looks like Nicollet is experiencing momentum toward reaching the state's speed goals.

<u>Mediacom¹</u> announced upgrades in 2017. <u>Consolidated Communications announced²</u> improvements in 2018. <u>County commissioners have recognized³</u> the need for better broadband. In 2019, <u>RS</u>
